#### Library Highlights & Achievements

Guided by the vision of the Chairman POF Board, 2024–2025 brought a new wave of modernization to the library. To improve digital access and services, 13 branded computers were installed, forming a fully equipped Digital Access Corner that allows users to browse, research, and complete academic tasks with ease. Internet bandwidth was increased fivefold—from 20MB to 100MB—resulting in significantly faster and smoother access to online journals, research databases, and e-resources.



In line with the library's digital transformation goals, core services such as book issuance, returns, and catalog searching were fully automated. This automation has reduced processing time, improved accuracy, and enhanced user satisfaction. Moreover, the library's website underwent a complete redesign, making it more user-friendly and responsive. Readers can now conveniently explore library services, track borrowed items, and access online catalogue from anywhere, anytime.

A major enhancement this year was the inclusion of book suggestions from general readers and educational institutions. This initiative allows library users to recommend titles, ensuring that the collection remains diverse, relevant, and responsive to community needs. These suggestions are reviewed and considered for procurement, aligning the library's offerings with the evolving academic and literary interests of its patrons.



The library continues to uphold an open-access policy, welcoming all visitors - students, researchers, professionals, and general readers - without restriction. This inclusive approach ensures that knowledge remains freely accessible to everyone. With its calm, well-lit reading spaces and supportive environment, the library continues to be a **conducive place for learning**, **reflection**, **and intellectual growth**.







#### Book Exchange – a social initiative

POF Central Library introduced a unique community service, the **Book Exchange Section**, dedicated to promoting the spirit of sharing and sustainability in reading. Initially, the idea was implemented for general book exchange to cater the readers interested in fiction, non-fiction, and other general interest titles. Encouraged by the positive response, the initiative was soon expanded to include textbook exchange, enabling students to obtain syllabus-related materials without financial strain.



As the new academic session approaches, an awareness campaign is being planned to further publicize the initiative, ensuring maximum participation and benefit.

The library also plans to formally engage both public and private sector schools in this initiative, expanding its reach and ensuring that a wider student community can benefit from the spirit of educational sharing.

With continued community interest, the **Book Exchange program** will fast become a symbol of collaborative learning and mutual help within the community.

#### 💐 Student Membership

Designed for students of local public and private schools and colleges, this subsidized membership allows access to thousands of academic and recreational resources. With simple documentation and a nominal annual fee, students can benefit from:

- Borrowing privileges
- Access to reference material and e-resources
- Use of digital facilities and study spaces

#### 👪 Private Membership

For the first time, the library has opened its doors to the general public through Private Membership. Individuals outside POF employment—such as professionals, educators and

avid readers-can now register and enjoy:

- Full borrowing privileges
- · Access to a rich collection of books across genres
- A quiet, resourceful space for reading and research

These additions reflect the library's mission to serve the broader community and promote lifelong learning.



#### **Trip Diaries – Connecting with Institutions**

This year, POF Central Library welcomed students and faculty from **15 educational institutions**, hosting a total of **1,004 students and 66 faculty members**. These visits were designed to introduce young learners to the world of books, research, and digital literacy, fostering a culture of reading and exploration.

Each tour included:

□ A **guided library tour**, familiarizing visitors with various sections, including general reading, research, and digital resources.

□ **Hands-on digital sessions**, where students explored the online catalog, learned about e-resources, and practiced book searches.

**IN Interactive orientation sessions**, covering membership benefits, borrowing policies, and the role of libraries in academic growth.



Faculty members expressed appreciation for the well-structured tours, highlighting how students found the sessions engaging and insightful. Many institutions have since encouraged their students to sign up for memberships and utilize the library's expanding resources.



As part of our commitment to outreach, we plan to extend invitations to more schools and colleges, ensuring that every student in the community has the opportunity to experience the power of knowledge firsthand.



#### Tech @ Library

Our digital transformation continues to evolve, with a strong focus on making library services more efficient, accessible, and user-friendly. This year, the library achieved full **automation of its core operations**, meaning all processes—from book issuance and returns to catalog browsing—are now managed through an integrated digital system. Visitors can now:

**Q** Search the catalog in real-time using dedicated search terminals within the library.

Issue and return books through automated modules, reducing waiting time and improving service accuracy.

**Check book availability** before visiting, helping users plan their reading in advance.

Reserve books that are currently on loan, ensuring fair and timely access once they are returned.
